



# Private Hire Vehicles (London) Act 1998

## 1998 CHAPTER 34

### *Further controls*

#### **30 Prohibition of certain signs, notices etc.**

- (1) The [<sup>F1</sup>licensing authority] may make regulations prohibiting the display in London on or from vehicles (other than licensed taxis and public service vehicles) of any sign, notice or other feature of a description specified in the regulations.
- (2) Before making the regulations the [<sup>F1</sup>licensing authority] shall consult such bodies appearing to [<sup>F2</sup>the authority] to represent the London cab trade and the private hire vehicle trade in London as [<sup>F2</sup>the authority] considers appropriate.
- (3) Any person who—
  - (a) drives a vehicle in respect of which a prohibition imposed by regulations under this section is contravened; or
  - (b) causes or permits such a prohibition to be contravened in respect of any vehicle,

is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 4 on the standard scale.
