85 Exemption from jury service.

- (1) ^{F1}
- (2) In Part III of Schedule 1 to the ^{M1}Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1980 (persons excusable as of right from jury service), after the entries in Group A there is inserted—

“GROUP AB

Scottish Parliament and [^{F2}Scottish Government]

- (a) members of the Scottish Parliament;
- (b) members of the [^{F2}Scottish Government]; and
- (c) junior Scottish Ministers.”
