Terrorist bombing and finance offences

62 Terrorist bombing: jurisdiction.

(1) If—

- (a) a person does anything outside the United Kingdom as an act of terrorism or for the purposes of terrorism, and
- (b) his action would have constituted the commission of one of the offences listed in subsection (2) if it had been done in the United Kingdom,

he shall be guilty of the offence.

(2) The offences referred to in subsection (1)(b) are—

- (a) an offence under section 2, 3 or 5 of the ^{M1}Explosive Substances Act 1883 (causing explosions, &c.),
- (b) an offence under section 1 of the ^{M2}Biological Weapons Act 1974 (biological weapons), and
- (c) an offence under section 2 of the ^{M3}Chemical Weapons Act 1996 (chemical weapons).
