MINOR AND CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS

Legal Aid Act 1988 (c. 34.)

- 8 (1) The Legal Aid Act 1988 is to have effect in relation to proceedings under—
- (a) sections 14B and 14D of the ^{M1}Football Spectators Act 1989,
 - (b) sections 14G and 14H of that Act (so far as relating to banning orders made under section 14B), and
 - (c) sections 21B(2) and 21D of that Act,
- as if those proceedings had been included in the definition of “criminal proceedings” in article 1(2) of the ^{M2}Access to Justice Act 1999 (Commencement No. 3, Transitional Provisions and Savings) Order 2000.
- (2) Sub-paragraph (1) is to have effect subject to any provision made by an order under section 3 of this Act or under section 108(1) of, or paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 14 to, the ^{M3}Access to Justice Act 1999.
