## Postal and money orders

## 113 Recoupment of losses on wrongly paid money orders.

- (1) Subsection (2) applies where—
  - (a) a money order issued by [<sup>F1</sup>a Post Office company] or a foreign postal administration has been delivered for collection to a banker, and
  - (b) [<sup>F2</sup>a Post Office company ("the company")] has paid the order to the banker when it should not have done so.
- (2) The sum paid may be deducted from sums subsequently falling to be paid by [<sup>F3</sup>the company] company to the banker by way of payment of money orders so issued which have been delivered to the banker for collection.
