PART VI

PROCEDURE

Public meetings

- (1) This paragraph applies to a meeting held by the Board for the purpose of receiving and considering a report on policing from the Chief Constable prepared for the meeting.
 (2) There must be at least [Fleight] meetings in each year.
 - () There must be at reast [eight] meetings in each
 - - (4) The Board must give such notice of a meeting as it considers appropriate.
 - (5) Members of the public may attend any meeting.
 - (6) But that does not prevent the Board from excluding the public, or particular members of the public, from a meeting, or from part of a meeting, in order to prevent or suppress disorderly conduct or other misbehaviour at, or a disturbance of, the meeting.
