THE POLICE

General functions

33 General functions of Chief Constable.

- (1) The police shall be under the direction and control of the Chief Constable.
- (2) In discharging his functions, the Chief Constable shall have regard to—
 - (a) the policing plan; and
 - (b) any code of practice under section 27.
