CHAPTER 4

GENERAL

58 Orders and regulations

- (1) Any power conferred on [^{F1}the Welsh Ministers] by this Part to make orders or regulations is exercisable by statutory instrument.
- (2) Any power conferred on [^{F1}the Welsh Ministers] or the Secretary of State to make an order or regulations under this Part includes power—
 - (a) to make such incidental, consequential, transitional or supplementary provision as [^{F1}the Welsh Ministers] or the Secretary of State thinks appropriate;
 - (b) to make different provision for different cases, including different provision for different localities and different bodies and descriptions of bodies.
