Local Safeguarding Children Boards

[^{F1}14A LSCBs: annual reports

- [^{F2}(1) At least once in every 12 month period, a Local Safeguarding Children Board established under section 13 must prepare and publish a report about safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children in its local area.
- (2) The Board must submit a copy of the report to the local Children's Trust Board.
- (3) For the purposes of this section—
- (a) the local area of a Local Safeguarding Children Board is the area of the [^{F3}local authority] that established the Board;
 - (b) the local Children's Trust Board, in relation to a Local Safeguarding Children Board, is the Children's Trust Board established for the Board's local area.]]
