

Civil Partnership Act 2004

2004 CHAPTER 33

An Act to make provision for and in connection with civil partnership. [18th November 2004]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
