#### Section 178: Door supervision

- 466. Where the Secretary of State or a licensing authority places a condition for door supervision on a premises licence, this will require entry to the premises to be supervised in order to prevent unauthorised access or occupation, outbreaks of disorder, or damage. Where such a condition is imposed, it a requirement of this section that the person undertaking the door supervision is licensed under the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c.12), where his conduct is licensable under that Act.
- 467. Schedule 16, at paragraph 17 makes minor amendments to the 2001 Act, which preserve the exemption from licensing afforded to bingo and casino operators under that Act.
