Kinds of mental health arrangements

- 52 (1) In determining whether P objects, regard must be had to all the circumstances (so far as they are reasonably ascertainable), including the following—
 - (a) P's behaviour;
 - (b) P's wishes and feelings;
 - (c) P's views, beliefs and values.
