Term of office

- The Secretary of State may remove a member who—
 - (a) has been absent from meetings of Natural England for a period longer than 6 months without the permission of Natural England,
 - (b) has become bankrupt[^{F1}or has had a debt relief order made in respect of him (under Part 7A of the Insolvency Act 1986)] or has made an arrangement with his creditors or has had his estate sequestrated in Scotland, or
 - (c) in the opinion of the Secretary of State is otherwise unable or unfit to carry out his duties.
