SCHEDULE 10

ANCILLARY PROVISIONS RELATING TO BOARDS

Acting through subsidiaries

- 1 (1) A section 87 order may include provision—
- (a) enabling the board to establish subsidiaries, and
 - (b) enabling or requiring the board to carry out specified functions through subsidiaries.
- (2) “Subsidiary” means a subsidiary as defined by [^{F1}section 1159 of the Companies Act 2006].
