2006 CHAPTER 45

Enforcement powers

29 Inspection relating to [F1 F2 assimilated] law]

- (1) An inspector may carry out an inspection in order to check compliance with regulations under section 12 which [F3 are [F2 assimilated] law].
- (2) An inspector may enter any premises in order to carry out an inspection under subsection (1).
- (3) Subsection (2) does not authorise entry to any part of premises which is used as a private dwelling.
