



# Animal Welfare Act 2006

## 2006 CHAPTER 45

### *Enforcement powers*

#### **29** Inspection relating to [<sup>F1</sup>[<sup>F2</sup>assimilated] law]

- (1) An inspector may carry out an inspection in order to check compliance with regulations under section 12 which [<sup>F3</sup>are [<sup>F2</sup>assimilated] law].
- (2) An inspector may enter any premises in order to carry out an inspection under subsection (1).
- (3) Subsection (2) does not authorise entry to any part of premises which is used as a private dwelling.
