  - (3) In subsection (2), after "(3)" insert " and to section 43(5) of the Administration of Justice Act 1985 ".
  - - (5) In subsection (4)—
      - (a) omit "and the Master of the Rolls", and
      - (b) for "they" substitute " it ".

(6) For subsection (6) substitute—

- "(6) Any decision of the High Court—
  - (a) on an application under section 43(3) or 47(1)(d), (e), (ea) or (f), or
  - (b) against an order under section 43(3A),
  - shall be final."

(7) Omit subsection (7).
