



# UK Borders Act 2007

## 2007 CHAPTER 30

### *Border and Immigration Inspectorate*

#### **55 Prescribed matters**

- (1) In sections 48 to 53 “prescribed” means prescribed by order of the Secretary of State.
- (2) An order under any of those sections—
  - (a) may make provision generally or only for specified purposes,
  - (b) may make different provision for different purposes, and
  - (c) may include incidental or transitional provision.
- (3) An order under any of those sections prescribing a person may specify—
  - (a) one or more persons, or
  - (b) a class of person.
- (4) An order under any of those sections—
  - (a) shall be made by statutory instrument, and
  - (b) shall be subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.
