GENERAL SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS

Interpretation

95 Meaning of "national authority"

- (1) In this Act "national authority" means any of the following—
 - (a) the Secretary of State;
 - (b) the Scottish Ministers;
 - (c) the Welsh Ministers;
 - (d) the relevant Northern Ireland department.
- (2) Functions conferred or imposed by this Act on "the national authorities" are to be exercised by all of them jointly.
