#### *Enforcement*

### 12 Injunctions restraining breaches of section 2(1)

- (1) Where the [F1OGA] considers it necessary or expedient to restrain any actual or apprehended breach of section 2(1), the [F1OGA] may apply to the court for an injunction or, in Scotland, an interdict.
- (2) An application may be made whether or not the [F1OGA] has exercised or is proposing to exercise any of the other powers under this Chapter.
- (3) On an application under subsection (1), the court may grant such an injunction or interdict as the court thinks appropriate for the purpose of restraining the breach.
- (4) Rules of court may provide for an injunction or interdict to be issued against a person whose identity is unknown.
- (5) In this section “the court” means—
  - (a) the High Court, or
  - (b) in Scotland, the Court of Session.
