### **30 Power to amend Consumer Credit Act 1974**

- (1) The Secretary of State may by order make such amendments to the Consumer Credit Act 1974<sup>F1</sup>, the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 and any statutory instrument made under that Act] as the Secretary of State considers appropriate in consequence of provision made by or under this Chapter.
- (2) Before exercising the power under subsection (1) the Secretary of State must consult—
  - (a) the <sup>F2</sup>Financial Conduct Authority], and
  - (b) such other persons as the Secretary of State considers appropriate.
