Regulations and orders

347 Regulations and orders: general

- (1) Any power of the [^{F1}Secretary of State] to make any regulations or order under this Act is exercisable by statutory instrument.
- (2) Subject to sections 348(1) and 349(1), regulations or orders of the [^{F1}Secretary of State] under this Act are subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of either House of Parliament.
- (3) Any regulations of the [^{F2}Secretary of State] or the Commission and any order of the [^{F2}Secretary of State] under this Act may make—
 - (a) different provision for different cases or descriptions of case or different purposes or areas, and
 - (b) such supplemental, incidental, consequential, transitory or transitional provision or savings as the [^{F2}Secretary of State] or, as the case may be, the Commission considers appropriate.
- (4) Nothing in this section applies to an order under paragraph 29 of Schedule 9 (transitory modifications).
