GENERAL

12 Abbreviations of Acts

In this Act—

“SSAA 1992” means the Social Security Administration Act 1992;

“SSA(NI)A 1992” means the Social Security Administration (Northern Ireland) Act 1992;

“SSCBA 1992” means the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992;

“SSCB(NI)A 1992” means the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992.

13 Commencement

(1) Part 1 comes into force on 6 April 2011.

(2) Part 2 and this Part come into force on the day on which this Act is passed.

14 Extent

(1) The amendments made by Part 1 have the same extent as the provisions to which they relate.

(2) Part 2 and this Part extend to England and Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.

15 Short title

This Act may be cited as the National Insurance Contributions Act 2011.
