2013 CHAPTER 21

An Act to make provision about the prosecution in Scotland of partnerships, partners and others following dissolution or changes in membership. [25th April 2013]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
