Criminal Justice and Public Order Act 1994

- [^{F1}42C(1) This paragraph has effect in relation to the application of section 137C of the 1994 Act where a person is arrested under section 137A by an immigration officer in respect of a specified offence other than one that is being investigated by an immigration officer.
- (2) Any reference to an officer of at least, or above, the rank of inspector in the arresting force is to be read as a reference to an immigration officer of at least, or above, the equivalent grade.
- (3) The reference in subsection (6)(a) to the arresting force is to be read as a reference to any immigration officer.]
