SCHEDULE 18

POWER TO RESTRICT CHARGES OR IMPOSE REQUIREMENTS IN RELATION TO SCHEMES

Overriding provision

- 6 (1) The Secretary of State may by regulations provide that specified provisions override any provision of a relevant scheme to the extent that it conflicts with them.
- [^{F1}(1A) The Secretary of State may by regulations provide that specified provisions override any term of a relevant contract to the extent that it conflicts with them.]
- (2) A “specified provision” is a provision of regulations under this Schedule specified in regulations made under sub-paragraph (1) [^{F2}or (1A)] .
- [^{F3}(3) “Relevant contract” means a contract between the trustees or managers of a relevant scheme and a person providing services in relation to the scheme.]
