 - (b) section 1A (causing serious injury by dangerous driving),
 - (c) section 2 (dangerous driving),
 - (d) section 3ZC (causing death by driving: disqualified drivers), or
 - (e) section 3ZD (causing serious injury by driving: disqualified drivers)."
