#### *Supplementary*

#### **53 Publication of details of sanctions**

- (1) The OGA may publish details of any sanction notice given in accordance with this Chapter.
- (2) But the OGA may not publish anything that, in the OGA's opinion—
  - (a) is commercially sensitive,
  - (b) is not in the public interest to publish, or
  - (c) is otherwise not appropriate for publication.
- (3) If, after details of a sanction notice are published by the OGA, the sanction notice is—
  - (a) cancelled on appeal, or
  - (b) withdrawn under section 55,the OGA must publish details of the cancellation or withdrawal.
