Authorisation: applications etc

6 Referral to Tribunal of refusal to grant authorisation

- (1) If the Pensions Regulator refuses to grant authorisation to a Master Trust scheme, the decision may be referred to the Tribunal by—
- the trustees, or
 - any other person who appears to the Tribunal to be directly affected by the decision.
- (2) In this section “the Tribunal”, in relation to a referral under subsection (1), means—
- the First-tier Tribunal, in any case where it is determined by or under Tribunal Procedure Rules that the First-tier Tribunal is to hear the reference;
 - the Upper Tribunal, in any other case.
