

Provisional Order (Marriages) Act 1905

1905 CHAPTER 23 5 Edw 7

- †Provisional orders for removing doubts as to validity of marriages. U.K.
 - (1) [F1Lord Chancellor] may, in the case of marriages solemnised in England which appear to him to be invalid or of doubtful validity by reason of some informality, make [F2 an order] for the purpose of removing the invalidity or doubt.
 - (2) The draft of every such order shall be advertised, in such manner as the [F3Lord Chancellor] thinks fit, not less than one month before the order is made, and the [F3Lord Chancellor] shall consider all objections to the order sent to him in writing during that month, and shall, if it appears to him necessary, direct a local inquiry into the validity of any such objections.
 - [F4(3) An order of the [F3Lord Chancellor] under this Act shall be subject to special parliamentary procedure.]
