4 Interpretation.

In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,—

The expressions “Registrar-General” and “registrar” mean respectively the Registrar-General within the meaning of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1836, and a superintendent registrar of marriages within the meaning of the ^{M1} Marriage Act, 1836; and
