GENERAL

Patent Office, and Proceedings thereat

63 Officers and clerks.

- (1) There shall continue to be a comptroller-general of patents, designs, and trade marks, and [^{F1}the Secretary of State] may, subject to the approval of the [^{F2}Minister for the Civil Service], appoint the comptroller, and so many examiners and other officers and clerks, with such designations and duties as [^{F1}the Secretary of State] think fit, and may remove any of those officers and clerks.
- (2) The salaries of those officers and clerks shall be appointed by [^{F1}the Secretary of State], with the concurrence of the [^{F2}Minister for the Civil Service]. . .
