	(1) The power to levy the duties on local taxation licences to which this section applies shall, [F5 in England and Wales be vested in the councils of districts].	
	(2) His Majesty may, by Order in Council, <sup>F6</sup> make provision for the furnishing by [F7 district councils] of returns to the Local Government Board as to the amounts levied under the power transferred by this section.
