An Act to grant certain duties of Customs and Inland Revenue, to alter other duties, and to amend the Law relating to Customs and Inland Revenue and the National Debt, and to make other provisions for the financial arrangements of the year. [1st August 1908]

LOCAL TAXATION LICENCES
†Collection of duties on certain local taxation licences by county councils.
(1) The power to levy the duties on local taxation licences to which this section applies shall, [Fin England F6 be vested in the councils of districts][F7 and in Wales be vested in the councils of counties and county boroughs].
(2) His Majesty may, by Order in Council, <sup>F8</sup> make provision for the furnishing by [F9F10] councils] of returns to the Local Government Board as to the amounts levied under the power transferred by this section.
