#### *Supplementary Provisions as to Legal Proceedings*

#### **105 Summary jurisdiction.**

- (1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, all orders of a court of summary jurisdiction under this Act shall be made, and all proceedings in relation to any such orders shall be taken, in manner [<sup>F1</sup>provided by the <sup>M1</sup>Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1975].
- (2) Any magistrate who, by virtue of a local Act had jurisdiction before the first day of April nineteen hundred and nine for any of the purposes of the <sup>M2</sup>Prevention of Cruelty to Children Act 1904, shall have jurisdiction for the like purposes of Part II of this Act.
