1962 CHAPTER 40

4 Interpretation

- (1) In this Act, and in any amendment made by this Act in any other enactment, "Jamaica " includes the islands known as the Morant Cays and the Pedro Cays and any other territories which at the passing of this Act are dependencies of the Colony of Jamaica, but does not include the Cayman Islands or the Turks and Caicos Islands; and in any Act of the Parliament of the United Kingdom passed after the passing of this Act, and in any instrument made after the passing of this Act by virtue of an Act of the Parliament of the United Kingdom (whenever passed), the expression "Jamaica" shall be taken to have the same meaning as in this Act unless a contrary intention is expressed in that Act or instrument, as the case may be.
- (2) References in this Act to any enactment are references to that enactment as amended or extended by or under any other enactment.
