- <sup>F12</sup> The following acts are and shall remain prohibited at any time and in any place whatsoever, whether committed by civilian or by military agents:
- (a) violence to the life, health, or physical or mental well-being of persons, in particular:
    - (i) murder;
    - (ii) torture of all kinds, whether physical or mental;
    - (iii) corporal punishment; and
    - (iv) mutilation;
  - (b) outrages upon personal dignity, in particular humiliating and degrading treatment, enforced prostitution and any form of indecent assault;
  - (c) the taking of hostages;
  - (d) collective punishments; and
  - (e) threats to commit any of the foregoing acts.]
