



Interest On Damages (Scotland) Act 1958

1958 CHAPTER 61 6 and 7 Eliz 2

3 Citation, interpretation, extent and commencement

(1) This Act may be cited as the Interest on Damages (Scotland) Act 1958.

[^{F1}(2) In this Act, “personal injuries” includes any disease and any impairment of a person’s physical or mental condition.]

(3) This Act shall extend to Scotland only, and shall not apply to any action commenced against any person before the passing of this Act.
