THIRD SCHEDULE

PROVISIONS AS TO COMPENSATION BY WAY OF PAYMENT OF COST OF WORKS

- 8 Where a notice has been given under paragraph 2 of this Schedule, and the applicant has incurred expenses in carrying out any of the work specified in that notice, and claims compensation in respect of those expenses—
- (a) if [^{F1}the final operator][^{F2}has not served]a counter-notice under paragraph 3 of this Schedule in respect of that notice, they shall not be entitled to object to that claim on any of the grounds mentioned in paragraph 4 of this Schedule;
 - (b) if [^{F1}the final operator][^{F2}has served]such a counter-notice, they shall not be entitled to object to that claim on any of the grounds mentioned in paragraph 4 of this Schedule, except in so far as the claim relates to items which were specified in the counter-notice and the objection is on grounds which were so specified in relation to those items.
