

# Emergency Laws (Repeal) Act 1959

### 1959 CHAPTER 19 7 and 8 Eliz 2

#### 10 Short title, duration and repeals.

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Emergency Laws (Repeal) Act 1959.
- (2) The provisions of this Act, other than sections . . . <sup>F1</sup> six therefore and this section, shall continue in force only until the expiration of the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, and shall then expire; and [F2 sections sixteen (1) and seventeen (2)(a) of the MI Interpretation Act 1978], shall apply upon the expiration of those provisions as if those provisions had then been repealed.
