## 1961 CHAPTER 64 9 and 10 Eliz 2

## PART I

## GENERAL

#### 1 Construction.

- (1) Part II of this Act [<sup>F1</sup>except so much of it as relates to building regulations] shall be construed as one with Part II of the <sup>M1</sup>Public Health Act 1936.
- - (4) Subject to the provisions of this Act, the provisions of the <sup>M2</sup>Public Health Act 1936, set out in the following table shall apply in relation to Part IV and Part VI of this Act as if the said Part IV and the said Part VI were contained in that Act.
