CHAPTER 139

FORGERY OF FOREIGN BILLS ACT 1803 (REPEALED)

- [1.] Persons forging, &c., foreign bills of exchange, &c. or tendering the same in payment, guilty of felony, and liable to be transported.
- 2 Persons engraving plates for foreign bills of exchange, &c., or printing them, without lawful authority, to be deemed guilty of a misdemeanour. Act not to alter any law in force for the punishment of forgery.
