1808 CHAPTER 138

XIII Conversion to be made according to the highest Fiar Price.

Provided always, and be it enacted, That where there shall have been or shall be different Rates of Annual Fiar Prices for any County or Stewartry, District or Place, struck in virtue of Authority from the Sheriff or Stewart, the said Conversion from Money into Grain or Victual, and from Grain or Victual into Money, in all of the Cases aforesaid, shall be made according to the highest Annual Fur Prices struck in virtue of Authority from the Sheriff or Stewart for the said County, Stewartry, District, or Place.
