XVI Extracts from Register of Great Seal to be probative.

And be it enacted, That Extracts of Writs from the Register of the Great Seal, of which the Fad and Date of Sealing mail have been duly recorded, such Extracts being certified in due Form by the Keepers of the said Records), shall make entire Faith in all Cases, excepting in Cases of Improbation.
