13 So much of Irish Act 37 G. 3 as appoints commissioners for the reduction of national debt in Ireland, repealed: British commissioners shall be commissioners for the reduction of the national debt of the United Kingdom.

^{F1} the commissioners for the reduction of the national debt of Great Britain shall be and become commissioners for the reduction of the national debt of the United Kingdom; and the said commissioners shall have all such powers and authorities as are or may be given in and by any Act or Acts in force in Great Britain or Ireland, relative to the reduction of the national debt of Great Britain or the national debt of Ireland;
