



# Public Offices (Scotland) Act 1817

## CHAPTER 64

### PUBLIC OFFICES (SCOTLAND) ACT 1817

- After Termination of existing Interest, the Salary of Keeper of the Great Seal for Scotland limited to 2,000l. per Annum.
- II Application of Fees.
  - III Salary of Keeper of the Privy Seal for Scotland in like Manner limited to 1,200l. per Annum.
  - IV Application of Fees.
  - V Duties of Office of Keeper of the Signet to be discharged by the Lord Register, whose Salary shall be limited to 1,200l. per Annum.
  - VI Application of Fees.
  - VII Provision in case the Office of Keeper of the Signet shall become vacant before that of Lord Register.
  - VIII Provision in case the Office of Lord Register shall become vacant before that of Keeper of the Signet.
  - IX Offices of Cashier and Receiver General of Excise regulated.
  - X Knight Marshal and Vice-Admiral.
  - XI Certain other Offices regulated.
  - XII Offices abolished.
  - XIII Treasury to order how Bishops Rents shall be collected.
  - XIV Treasury to lay before Parliament a comparative Statement of former and new Establishment of any Office regulated, and Statement of every Office abolished.
  - XV Regulation of any Office existing previous to 6 Anne, c.7 not to bring it within the Provisions of that Act.
