1823 CHAPTER 55

XIV Deed or Lease produced by Persons registering Freehold to be indorsed by Clerk of the Peace.

And be it further enacted, That every Deed, Lease, or Instrument produced by any Person intending to register a Freehold under the Value of Twenty Pounds as aforesaid, shall be indorsed at the Time in open Court, by the acting Clerk of the Peace, with his Name, and the Day of the Month and Year, and the Clerk of the Peace shall then and there compare the Deed, Lease, or Instrument, with the Affidavit of Registry.
