1823 CHAPTER 55

XV Registry not to be impeached for Irregularity in holding Sessions.

And be it further enacted, That the Registry of any Freehold shall not be impeached on account of any Irregularity in the holding or adjourning of any Sessions from whence the Sessions at which such Freehold shall have been registered shall have been adjourned, either directly or by any Adjournment or Adjournments, provided such latter Sessions shall have been duly and regularly held in all other respects.
