1824 CHAPTER 83 5 Geo 4

14 Persons aggrieved may appeal to the next sessions.

Any person aggrieved by any Act or determination of any justice or justices of the peace out of sessions, in or concerning the execution of this Act, may appeal to [^{F1}the Crown Court] . . . ^{F2}
