

Vagrancy Act 1824

1824 CHAPTER 83

XXII Not to extend to repeal any Act in force in Scotland or Ireland relative to the Removal of Poor, &c.

Provided also, and be it further enacted, That nothing herein contained shall be construed to extend or apply to *Scotland* or *Ireland*, nor to alter any Law now in force for the Removal of poor Persons; born in *Scotland*, *Ireland*, or the *Isles of Man*, *Jersey*, and *Guernsey*, and becoming chargeable to Parishes in *England*, such Persons not having committed Acts of Vagrancy as herein-before described, nor to alter any Law now in force relating to Lunatic Vagrants.
